Prof. (Dr.) Naresh Kumar Vats, is presently working as **Professor of Law-cum-Registrar** at Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab. He did Ph.D., LL.M. and B.A. from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra; LL.B. from Barkatullah Vishwavidyalaya, Bhopal and passed UGC (NET) Law. He has also obtained M.B.A. (HR) and PGDPM and Labour Welfare and Interpretership Diploma in (Sinhala) foreign language. Professor Vats has been teaching Intellectual Property Laws and Law of Corporate Finance and Taxation, Family Law, Commercial Arbitration Mechanism and Cyber Law at Undergraduate and Post-Graduate level.
